

VINTAGE KNITS

iPad Mini Cover



A quick and easy cover to knit for your Mini

Yarn: I used bulky weight yarn from my stash, not sure what it was (a wool blend) I don't think I used more than 75 yards

Needles: US #10

Finished (block) dimensions: 9" long x 4.5" wide. This creates a fairly snug cover for your Mini

Gauge: 4.5 sts= 1" in cable pattern (blocked)

Abbreviations:

K: knit

P: purl

C3F: cable – slip 3 sts to a cable needle and hold in front, knit next 3 sts, then knit 3 sts from cable needle

Instructions:

Cast on 40 stitches

Rows 1, 5 and 7: *p1, k6, p1; rep from * to end of row

All wrong side rows: *k1, p6, k1; rep from * to end of row

Row 3: *p1, C3F, p1; rep from * to end of row

Repeat these 8 rows until you have completed 6 cables, ending with Row 4. Work in k1, p1 ribbing for 2”, bind off in ribbing.

Finishing: Sew bottom and side seams, weave in ends, block cover.

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
